

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Bath County Board of Supervisors will meet on July 10, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter, in Room 115 of the Bath County Courthouse to receive public input on, discuss, and consider amending Chapter 15 of the Bath County Code, specifically adding the following language:

### Section 15-32 Definitions

**Eligible historic lodging property. A structure (i) that contains 450 or more rooms for overnight lodging purposes, (ii) that is situated on one or more parcels of land exceeds 700 acres, and (iii) of which some or all portions of the structure were constructed prior to 1930.**

and

### Section 15-33 Levy and Rate

**(c) Effective August 1, 2018, in addition to all other transient occupancy taxes levied under this section, there is hereby imposed an additional transient occupancy tax of five percent on eligible historic lodging properties in the County. All revenues collected from this additional tax shall be designated solely as local funds to be used to incentivize other entities to invest in substantial rehabilitation, renovation, and expansion projects on eligible historic lodging properties that would enhance local economic development and tourism opportunities.**
