The Bath County Planning Commission will meet on Monday, July 23, 2018 at **6:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter, in Room 115 of the Bath County Courthouse to receive public input on, discuss, and consider the following:

Franz and Jean von Schilling – (TMs#63A2-1-4, 63A2-1-4B, 63A1-35A) – Rezoning application to rezone property from R-5 Planned Unit Development and B-1 Convenience Business to A-2 Agricultural General. The property is a historical landmark with an historical easement in place, which would prohibit development as set forth in R-5 zoning. The B-1 Business District would be used as agriculture as well. The property would remain a farm, commonly known as Oakley Farm. The property is located 170 Oakley Farm Lane, Warm Springs, Virginia and comprises 66.246 acres. The property is located in the Warm Springs Magisterial District.
